大家期待的 2007 年美東夏令會已大致準備完成，籌備會在此寄上報名表及相關資料，請您儘早報名，以幫助我們作業。

「民主有公義，臺灣向前行」 Democracy with Justice, Taiwan Thrives! 是咱今年的主題。希望在 2008 年台灣大選之前，咱大家作伙來思考如何幫助台灣成爲一個民主兼法治，自由有公義的新國家。相信我們用心安排的精彩節目（詳見附頁:2007 年美東台灣人夏令會節目計畫表），包括辜寬敏與王美琇，葉菊蘭（暫定），陳師孟，陳茂雄，涂醒哲，簡余晏，徐國勇，王世堅，徐永明（暫定），高成炎，及江建祥等人的主題演講，陳昱霖的石雕藝術展覽，再加上與我們生活有關的各項專題演講，以及豐富的第二代節目（詳見附頁:2007 TACEC Youth Program），尤其是精彩的音樂會和台灣之夜晚會，將會帶給您闔家難忘的經驗與感受。

今年麻州大學提供有「校園旅館」、「冷氣宿舍」和「一般宿舍」三種不同的住宿，大致說明如下（詳見附頁: 住宿選擇）：

- 一、 校園旅館 Campus Center Hotel：請自行向校園旅館部訂房及付費，務必於確定訂有房間後，再選擇” Conference & Meals” 的報名方式。
- 二、 冷氣宿舍：2006 年新建，四間單人房共用兩套衛浴，客廳與沙發。
- 三、 一般宿舍：傳統無空調學生宿舍，兩人共用一房間，衛浴位於每層樓中央。

因爲住宿有不同的選擇，加上青少年有集合住宿(Youth Housing)，以及 5 至 10 歲兒童必須與父母同住，所以報名方式與費用也有多種選擇（成人有 A,B,C,D 四種選項，青少年及兒童有 E,F,G,H 四種選項，詳見附頁: 報名方式及費用表）。有意參加文成盃網球賽，請組隊向高龍榮報名（詳見比賽辦法附頁）；有意參加高爾夫球賽或笑話比賽，請填寫附表（在比賽辦法附頁中）所需的個人資料連同報名表寄回（TACEC Registration, 16 Wellington Lane Ave., Lexington, MA 02421）。

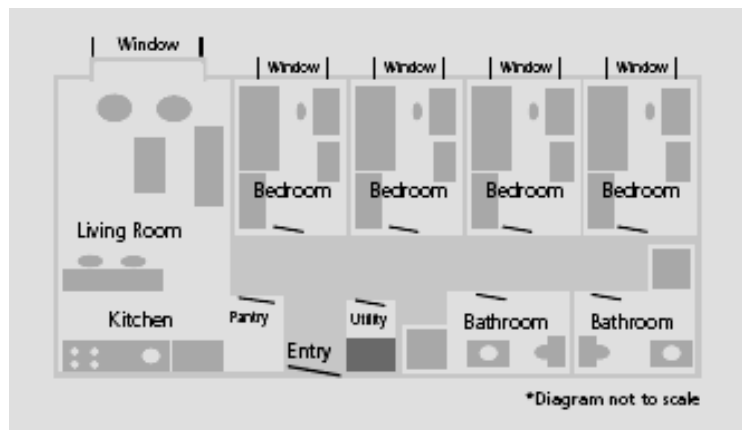
Lodging Choices

I. Campus Center Hotel

- Please contact the hotel directly (Tel: 413-549-6000 ext.7714) by **May 31**, and mentioned the block number (**Block # 1913**) to secure your reservation.
- 60 rooms are blocked for our conference. First come, first served.
- \$81.00 per room per night for single or double occupancy, Thursday (6/28) night.
- \$100.00 per room per night for single or double occupancy, Friday (6/29) and Saturday (6/30) nights.
- \$10.00 per cot per night.
- Lodging cost is paid directly to the hotel. Please select Category **B. Conference & Meals** on the registration form (see the “Registration Categories and Fee Schedule” page).

II. Air-Conditioned Apartment (North Residence Hall)

- Please register before **May 26** to ensure your reservation.
- Newly constructed in 2006. Each apartment includes four single bedrooms with a desk and a dresser, two full bathrooms, and a shared living room area (ideal for two couples).
- Lodging cost is included in the registration fee.

III. Non-Air-Conditioned Residence Halls

- Each room is arranged for double occupancy. Residence halls are not air-conditioned and no elevator. Public bathrooms are centrally located on each floor.
- You can bring your own fan for cooling in the night.
- Lodging cost is included in the registration fee.

Note: For both A/C and Non-A/C accommodations, linen service will be provided one set per bed including a flat sheet, fitted sheet, pillow, blanket, and two towels. Soap and plastic cups will be available at the front desk in the residence hall lobby.

- A.** This category only includes all of the seminars, the concert and Taiwan Night. No room or meals.
- B.** This category is for those who are staying in the Campus Hotel. Please make your own room reservation with the hotel (see the attachment: Lodging Choice for details). Please remember to mark your staying nights on the registration form so that we can prepare your meal card(s) accordingly.
- C.** Air-conditioned (A/C) rooms are not guaranteed if postmarked after 5/26/2007. Non-A/C rooms will be assigned, if no more A/C rooms are available by then.
- D.** Non A/C rooms have two single beds in each room and share hallway bathrooms.
- E.** Youths who are 11 to 22 years old (as of 7/1/2007) may sign up for Youth Housing (in Non A/C dorms). Youth housing is subsidized by TAC/EC Board and limited to first 70.
- F.** Children 5 to 10 years old have to stay with parents. As required by the school, there can be no more than one adult and one child (10 years and younger) in each A/C room. Any child who is 10 and under can stay with one parent in a room (bring a sleeping bag or blankets (and pillow) - no cots will be provided). Children who stay with parents in non-A/C dorms will have their own beds.
- G.** Children who are 11 years and older and stay in the A/C dorm must have their own room and will have to pay a different rate. Children who stay with parents in non-A/C dorms will have their own beds.
- H.** Children who are 4 years and younger are free of charge, but must share beds and meals with parents.

Note: The school charges the same room & meal rates as adults for children who are 5 years and older. The fee difference is subsidized by TAC/EC Board.
